## What a great start!

There is so much to celebrate already! The children achieved fantastic results in their end of year tests in the summer and are already building upon this, this year.

Heres a few headlines from the summer results:

- Our Year 1 children have got off to a great start as when they were in EYFS they achieved above children nationally in 6/7 of the areas of learning
- 100% of children in Year 1 passed the phonics screening test. Therefore we are one of the highest achieving schools in the country!
- The Year 2 children achieved above national average in reading and maths
- The Year 6 children did well in their SATS tests. They achieved the same as children nationally with our most able children achieving higher results than children locally and nationally in reading and maths.

We are so proud of all of our children and the way that they approach their learning, this year the children have already got off to a good start and we are looking forward to you seeing for yourselves when we hold our parents evening sessions in two weeks time.

#### Free School Meals

If you are willing to share a few details with us we can check a child's eligibility for a Free School Meal, eligibility provides additional funding for the school. Any additional funding is always welcome as school budgets become tighter year on year. School can claim this funding even if your child chooses to have packed lunches.
