Covid-19 Update

Guidance from the government has been issued recently about attendance for children as we emerge from the pandemic which states that:

Children with mild symptoms of any respiratory infection including covid-19, but are otherwise well, should continue to attend school. They should stay home if they have a high temperature and are unwell, and can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature/feel well enough. It is not recommended that children should have a covid-19 test unless directed to by a health professional, but if a child under 18 does test positive, they should stay off school for 3 days after the day they took the test. They can return to school after the 3 days if they are well enough.
