

## **PSHE Progression Map 2021-22**



Whilst Outwood Primary School follows the 1decision scheme of work, we carefully reflect on the needs of our own school community by allowing all teachers to be flexible in their delivery. It may mean that the 'who keeps us safe?' unit in year 2 takes four weeks of lessons and 'brushing teeth' just one week in 2021. However, in 2022, with a different cohort, this is reversed. By using the baseline assessment, teachers will be able to see what requires a longer and deeper level of learning and which they can move more swiftly on.
